

Clark's Story

This is Clark, age 5. Clark has experienced developmental delays requiring speech, occupational, and physical therapy since he was 18 months old. At age 3, one neurologist ordered an MRI to rule out cerebral palsy and a tethered spinal cord; all results came back negative. In June 2025, a second neurologist ordered genetic testing to further evaluate CP. The results returned as SPG7 Autosomal Dominant Inheritance. Clark is scheduled to begin a clinical trial in two weeks at Scottish Rite in Dallas through SP-CERN
